The content of the Video/DVD and Video Game materials may be explicit in nature and subject to viewer and parental discretion. The Library's Video/DVD collection may include foreign and domestic titles rated R, or not rated at all by the Motion Picture Association of America. The Library's Video Game materials may include titles rated M for mature, or not rated at all.

Parents assume full responsibility for the return, damage, fees, or fines for materials loaned and hold the Deerfield Public Library harmless from the loan of any materials.
