

FRIENDS OF THE DUNDEE LIBRARY MEETING OCTOBER 19, 2011

Minutes: Diane C moved to accept the minutes of the September meeting, second by Mary Lynne, carried.

No Treasurer's report

Book Sale: The sign up sheet for the book sale was emailed and also passed around at the meeting.

Truck: Anne and her husband will drive the truck. Diane C will go to help. Bonnie will organize setting up the room.

We need to buy 4 more tables to replace the old/heavy tables now stored under the stairs in the library. We also need to buy a cart to store all the tables, the 13 we have (now in the storage unit) and the 4 new ones. We can then store them in the library.

We need some carts on Wednesday and on Sunday to move books. Mary Todd will set up the money box. Fred Bazzoli will come on Thursday to go over the books; he will also bring us some to sell. He will come back on Sunday to take away anything that has not sold.

Books will be donated to : FISH Food Pantry, Community Crisis Center, Blood Bank, Juvenile Justice, Provena St. Joe's Hospital.

We need paper bags for the "bag sale" on Saturday. We have enough plastic bags.

We will again give one free paperback book to those who bring food for the FISH Food Pantry. One book for each food item – canned, packaged non-perishable goods.

Roxane: The Library has won the Jet Blue Soar with Reading sweepstakes – a partnership with PBS Kids and Jet Blue Airlines. The prize is \$10,000 worth of children's books from Random House. On Nov. 9 at 10 am, Jet Blue will present a big check to the library. Friends are encouraged to attend – wearing their Friends T-shirts. Google "Soar With Reading" for more info. Kids who entered the contest nominated their library; out of 100,000 nominations, Dundee was chosen. A display about the prize will be created for the children's room. The library will not be able to choose the books they want, if the library does not want to add any to their collection, the books will be used for prizes for reading programs.

PA system: we will practice with it; library staff will set up and charge up the battery.

Literacy Connection sent a thank you to the FOL for sponsoring the Bunco Event – 50 players participated and \$1,000 was raised. There were about 10 volunteers from FOL and Literacy Connection.

Events: Lorraine. A Mystery Writers' Tea will be held on January 21 and again on March 3 2012. Lorraine went through events planned for the remainder of this year – all info is on the website and in the newsletter. Registration for events can be done on the website, put in your email address to get a reminder.

Keys for the storage unit have been ordered. Each team will have a color coded key. There has been no response to the request for a back up/5th week team to move books to the storage unit.
