SUMMER READING CLUB— GET IN THE GAME, READ!

On June 9th the Children's Department of the Dundee Township Public Library will open this year's summer reading club, "Get in the Game, Read!", using a sports theme with incentives and events relating to popular sports.

The reading requirements are based on time spent reading by various age groups. The preschoolers through kindergarteners will need to read 300 minutes (5 hours), 1st through 5th graders will read for 600 minutes (10 hours), and 6th through 8th graders will need to complete



900 minutes of reading (15 hours).

Children will be given logs to record their reading times. Incentives will be awarded at halfway and completion.

Reading requirements must be completed by August 2nd with no exceptions.

10TH ANNUAL SAFETY DAY

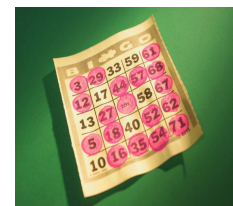
