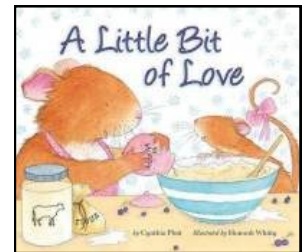
Turkey Dinner

Three Little Hot Dogs

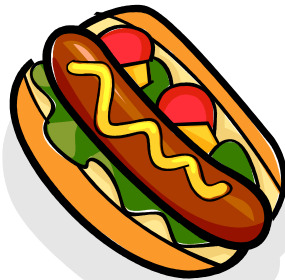
Three little hot dogs frying in the pan.

Turkey Action Rhyme

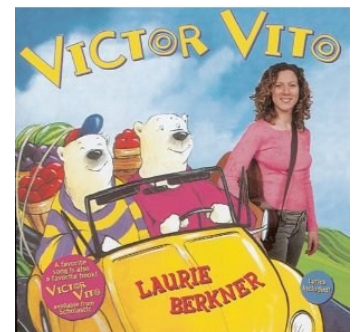
(Tune of ~ I'm a Little Teapot)
