

CLASSIFICATIONS FOR EASY READERS

As you browse the aisles in search of an Easy Reader you will notice 1, 2, and 3 stickers on the books' spines.

These numbers represent the appropriate reading level for these books.

1=The easiest of the 3 levels. These books are for those just learning to read.

2=These books have more sentences on a page and a larger vocabulary than level 1 books.

3=These are the hardest of all the Easy Readers. You will find paragraphs and more diverse vocabulary. These books are the last step for children before they start reading chapter books.
