Art of Edvard Munch explored in La Grange Public Library program on February 3

LaGrange, IL – January 22, 2009 – To prepare for the Art Institute of Chicago's upcoming exhibit, the La Grange Public Library will host the program *Edvard Munch: The Frieze of Life* on Tuesday, February 3 at 7 p.m.

Art historian Dr. Michelle Paluch-Mishur will present an in depth look at artist Edvard Munch with a slide lecture. She will discuss Munch's intriguing artistic vision through a study of paintings and prints that relate closely to his biography. Paluch-Mishur will also discuss how this pioneer of expressionism explored human misery through haunting imagery.
